2019年香港柔道隊際錦標賽

Hong Kong Judo Team Championships 2019 (非本地計分賽事)

主辦: 中國香港柔道總會 **資助:** 康樂及文化事務署

日期: 2019年9月22日(星期日)

時間: 上午十時半開始 **地點:** 大角咀體育館

比賽方式: 採淘汰及八強復活制方式進行

比賽細則:

1. 男子組: 每隊之運動員人數為5名,限制合共410公斤,而最輕者不得少於55公斤。

- 2. 女子組: 每隊之運動員人數為5名,限制合共330公斤,而最輕者不得少於45公斤。
- 3. 男子組/女子組: 比賽時間 4 分鐘

每場比賽採用五局三勝制。裁判必須定出每局比賽的勝方。

4. 先進組 (男子年齡 45 歲或以上,女子年齡 35 歲或以上): 每隊之運動員人數為5名(3 男 2 女),

第1,3和5場比賽將由男選手進行。第2和第4場比賽將由女選手進行。

比賽時間 3 分鐘, 比賽順序將從最年輕到最年長。

獲勝方將由 Waza-ari 或以上決定。如果在比賽結束時打和(Hikiwake'),將以抽籤決勝負。不設黃金時間。

在贏得相同場次的情況下,獲勝方將由 Ippon 勝(包括 FusenGachi, KikenGachi 和 SogoGachi) 或 Wazari 勝的數量決定。 在獲得相同數量的比賽和獲勝分數的情況下(Hikiwake'),將以抽籤決勝負。

每隊必須同時齊集各隊員進行過磅,否則當棄權論。

資格: (1) 出賽者必須在四級(橙帶)或以上。

- (2) 年齡必須在十四歲以上,如年齡未滿十八歲者須家長或監護人簽署同意。
- (3) 各團體限報男,女子組各一隊作賽。先進組不限
- (4) 男子組限報二十四隊,女子組限報八隊。 先進組不限,先到先得。

裁判: 由中國香港柔道總會安排

獎勵: 各級組別設冠、亞及兩名季軍

報名費: 每組每隊 港幣三百元正

服裝: 參賽者需自備符合柔道比賽的**白色**柔道袍, 女運動員必須穿著純白圓領 T-shirt 在內。

截止報名日期: 2019年9月9日(星期一), 過期報名不接受

量體重: 參賽者請於比賽當天帶備身份證明文件, 往比賽場地辦理量體重及登記手續。

非正式量體重: 上午九時至九時二十九分

女子組及先進組女子正式量體重: 上午九時三十分至九時五十五分

男子組及先進組男子正式量體重: 上午十時至十時三十分 參賽者必須按上述編排辦理量體重及登記手續,適時作棄權論。

賽程: 有關當天賽事詳細程序,請於比賽期間留意大會廣播。

比賽規例:

比賽將根據國際柔道聯合會體育及組織規例,國際柔道聯合會裁判規例及亞洲柔道聯盟技術指引進行。

參賽者須知:

- 1. 參加者需要負責自己的身體狀況及健康,並考慮是否適宜申請參加本賽事。如有疑問,請徵詢醫生的意見。
- 2. 本會只接受網上報名。
- 3. 參加者的年齡以比賽當天計算。
- 4. 報名經確實後,參加者有責任繳付所需費用。
- 5. 除情况特殊外,所有項目一經報名,不得申請退款,轉組或由他人代替參加。
- 6. 本會有權決定接受或拒絕任何申請。
- 7. 活動舉行期間,參加者須顧及自身安全,並須遵從工作人員之指示,如遇意外事故,包括財物遺失,身體損傷等,本會概不負責。如有任何不適,須立即向有關工作人員尋求協助。
- 8. 活動負責人及本會職員有權拒絕不守紀律之參加者繼續參與活動,所繳之費用概不發還。

- 11. 若活動舉行前兩小時,天文台懸掛雷暴警告訊號,黃色暴雨戒備訊號,紅色暴雨警告訊號,三號或以下颱風訊號,是次活動將依天氣情況及場地許可的情況下,活動負責人決定是否繼續進行,如參加者收不到任何通知,則表示活動按照原定時間,地點舉行。

Co-organized by The Judo Association of Hong Kong, China Subvented by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department

Date: 22nd September 2019 (Sunday)
Time: Commence at 10:30am

Mode of Competition: The elimination system with Quarter final repechage.

Details of competition:

Venue:

- 1. MEN GROUP: Five players per team, the total weight of the team must be less than 410kg and the lightest player should be over 55kg.
- 2. WOMEN GROUP: Five players per team, the total weight of the team must be less than 330kg & the lightest player should be over 45kg.
- 3. MEN/WOMEN GROUP: Duration is 4 minutes.

Tai Kok Tsui Sports Centre

Five games and three wins system. The referees must be taken an obligatory decision in each contest.

4. MASTER GROUP (Male Players must be age 45 or above and Female player must be age 35 or above):

Five players per team (3 men and 2 women).

The 1st, 3rd and 5th Match will be played by male players. The 2nd and 4th match will be played by female players.

Duration is 3 minutes. Order of the competition will be from the youngest to the oldest.

The winner will be decided by Waza-ari or above.

If there is tie (Hikiwake') at the end of the contest, the result will be decided by draw. No Golden Score.

In the case of equal number of contests won, the number of matches winning by Ippon (including FusenGachi, KikenGachi, and SogoGachi) OR by Wazari will decide the winner.

In the case of equal number of contests won and winning scores (Hikiwake'), the result will be decided by draw.

5. Each team must have all players at once in the weigh-in process.

Entry Requirement: (1) Team players should be holders of 4th Kyu (Orange Belt) or higher.

- (2) Players must be over age 14 and whose age under 18 must be countersigned by the parents or guardians.
- (3) Limit one team of Men Group or/and Women Group for one club. No limitation for Masters
- (4) Limit 24 teams for the Men's and 8 teams for Women's Group, No limitation for Masters

first come first served basis.

Referees: Arranged by the Judo Association of Hong Kong, China

Prize: Trophies will be awarded for Champion, 1st runner-up and two 2nd runners-up for each category

Entry Fee: HK\$300.00 per team per group

Uniform of Competition: White Judo-gi should be used and it must be suitable for judo competition

(the female players must wear a white round collar T-shirt inside)

Deadline: 9th September 2019 (Monday). Late entry will not be accepted.

Weigh-in and Registration: Official weigh-in and registration are held on the day of competition at venue. Please bring along your I. D.

Women Group & Women of Master Group Official Weigh-in: 09:30 to 09:55 am
Men Group & Men of Master Group Official Weigh-in: 10:00 to 10:30 am

All competitors must follow the weigh-in and registration time-schedule. Late-comers will be regarded as having withdrawn from the competition.

Competition Schedule: Please pay attention to the organizing committee's announcement for details about the competition schedule.

Method of Competition:

Competition is conducted in accordance with the IJF Sport and Organization Rules, IJF Refereeing Rules and JUA Technical Code.

Notes to Participants:

- 1. Participants should be aware of their health conditions and consider whether it is suitable for them to enroll in this competition. In case of doubt, please consult a doctor prior to the enrollment of competition.
- 2. Only on-line enrollment is accepted.
- 3. Participants' age is calculated based on the commencement date of the competition.
- 4. All entry fees must be settled once enrollment is confirmed.
- 5. Unless under special circumstances, no application for refund, change of category or making substitution is allowed after enrollment.
- 6. The Judo Association of Hong Kong, China reserves the right to accept or reject any applications.
- 7. Participants should be responsible for their own safety and should follow the instructions from our staff. Our Association is not liable for any loss of personal belongings or harm caused to the participants during the activities. Participants should report to the staff if feeling unwell.
- 8. Instructors and staff of The Judo Association of Hong Kong, China can disallow anyone who fails to observe instructions to continue his/her participation of the activities during the competition. No refund is entertained.
- 9. No appeal for this competition. The referee at that match makes the final decision.
- 10. In case the typhoon signal No.8 or above or black rainstorm warning signal is issued, all activities will be cancelled. (In case that the No.8 or above or black rainstorm warning signal is cancelled two hours before an activity commences and that the venue condition permits, all activities will be held as scheduled. Participants should consider the actual weather and traffic conditions when deciding whether or not to attend the activity.)
- 11. In case the thunderstorm warnings or amber rainstorm warning or red rainstorm warning signals, typhoon signal No.3 or below is issued two hours before an activity commences and the venue condition permits, the championship will be held as scheduled or cancelled. The activity will be held as scheduled without further notice.
- 12. The Judo Association of Hong Kong, China reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions without advance notice.
